

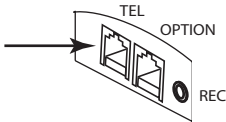
# SUPER SWITCH USER GUIDE

Thank you for purchasing the Super Switch (SS).

We have included this User Guide for your convenience so you may quickly enjoy the many features of your SS.

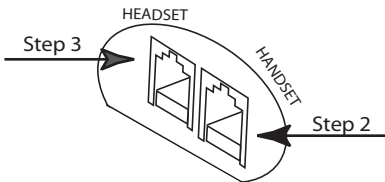
## Setup of your MPS

STEP 1 Plug butt cable provided into SS socket labelled "TEL".



STEP 2 Plug handset cable into SS socket labelled "HANDSET".

STEP 3 Plug headset cable into SS socket labelled "HEADSET".



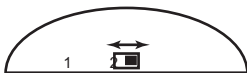
## Making a telephone call

- To make a telephone call using your handset, make sure headset/handset button is depressed.
- To make a telephone call using your telephone headset, release the headset/handset button.

## Troubleshooting

If the person you are attempting to call cannot hear you, check the following:

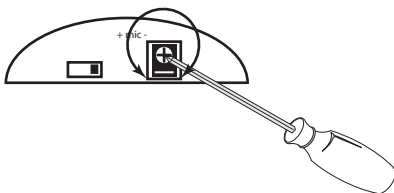
1. mute is not activated, and
2. try adjusting polarity switch, if the unit does not function in position 1, try position 2.



## Microphone volume control

(Not available on all models).

- Microphone volume increases when a screwdriver is rotated anti-clockwise.
- Microphone volume decreases when a screwdriver is rotated clockwise.



## Mute switch

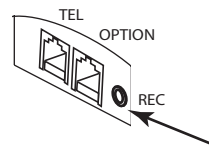
- To use mute, depress the mute button.
- To turn mute off release the mute button.

## Recording mode

The SS recording jack allows the user to record both sides of the telephone conversation.

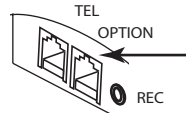
Additional equipment, such as a Digital Voice Recorder (DVR), is required for the recording feature.

Simply plug the DVR into the recording jack at the rear of the switch.



## Training mode

The "OPTION" socket at the rear of the SS is available for an additional headset or handset to be plugged in for training purposes.



The HeadsetExperts.com SS has three training mute modes:

O = When mute is depressed the optional headset socket only is muted.



OH = When mute is depressed both headset sockets are muted.



H = When mute is depressed the headset socket only is muted.



Please select the required training mode prior to commencing training.

## Storage and handling

1. Storage
  - Avoid places that have direct sunlight, poor ventilation, moisture, dust or electrical noises.
